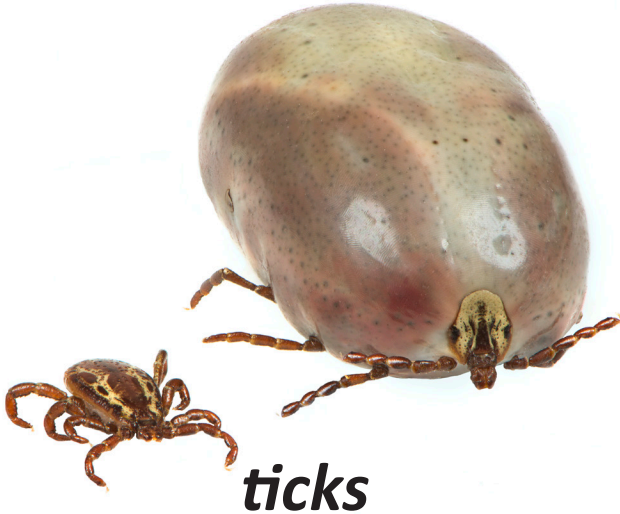


Love Your Pets?

Protect Them from Vectors!

Ticks, fleas, & mosquitoes bite & suck blood from vertebrate animals.

They can transmit (vector) bacteria, viruses, & heart worms that cause disease.

Feral & other unwanted animals enter your yard, bringing with them a host of parasites.

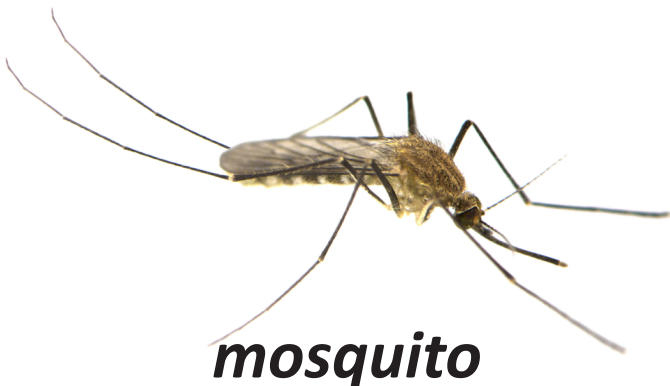
Some of those unwanted animals can physically harm your pets.

Vex those Vectors

- Keep your pets on flea and tick control.
- Discourage feral & other unwanted animals from your yard.
- Feed & water pets indoors, or at least bring their food & water indoors at night.
- Pick up & dispose pet waste daily.
- Keep trash cans & compost covered.
- Thin out dense shrubs where vectors often hide & nest.
- Prune vegetation away from fences & walls.
- Empty out standing water sources to eliminate mosquito larvae.
- Change bird bath water at least once a week.
- Clean up spilled bird seed often.
- Use baffles to keep unwanted animals out of bird feeders.
- Install metal fencing to 24 inches below grade to prevent animals from burrowing under the fence.
